Code of Conduct

We strive to provide a safe outdoor experience for all Scouts and families participating in program at Camp Greenough. **The Scout Oath and Scout Law are our guiding principles.** Additionally all staff and participants in Cape Cod and Islands Council program are expected to abide by the following:

All participants will be **respectful of others and their property.**

All adults, including leaders and parents accompanying youth participants, are expected to support camp and program staff by maintaining discipline and activity-specific rules.

Corporal punishment, including spanking, is prohibited.

No camper shall be subjected to cruel or severe punishment, humiliation, or verbal abuse from camp staff, participants or visiting parents.

No camper shall be denied food or shelter as a form of punishment

No child shall be punished for soiling, wetting or not using a toilet.

The **Buddy System** is in effect at all times while in camp. No youth may travel on his own or leave his group without permission of the group leader.

In accordance with National BSA policy, use of alcohol, illegal drugs, and tobacco products is expressly prohibited on any Council property.

Violation of any of these policies may result in the individual being removed from the activity or program and possibly sent home.
